‘Train of Events’ Free Event Stewards Courses in 2011

Due to the interest and increase in events leading up to 2012 across the region Volunteer Centre Dorset is running more free training courses for Volunteer Event Stewards.

The **‘Introduction to Event Stewarding’** will be run over two days
The first of these will be held at the **Weyline Lounge at Weymouth Football Club, Bob Lucas Stadium On 19th May followed by the second session on the 26th May**

Thus far the centre has ran a variety of courses across the region which have proved highly popular. However due to activity surrounding the events in Weymouth and Portland the centre with the support of Southwest forum are hosting two more courses.

Successful candidates will be registered with the centre have the unique opportunity to be involved with the Weymouth and Portland Ambassadors Programme which will support the hosting of games related events during 2012.

Course content includes preparing for spectator events, controlling entry exit and movement of people, monitoring spectators dealing with crowd problems, managing conflict, contributing to teamwork, and dealing with emergencies,

Successful completion of the course will involve confirmation of attendance supporting two local events

All courses include refreshments plus free lunch. The course is available to volunteers aged 18 or over and not in full time education. However numbers are limited therefore please register your interest early to confirm your place
A booking fee of £30 is being charged which is fully refundable on attendance
