

Volunteering; what does it mean for me?

First of all it means you get to **meet new people** and have fun. Volunteering gives you the chance to get involved in your local community, **use your skills** and **develop new ones**. You can help manage organisations, work on a one to one basis with individuals or get physical on environmental projects. You can give **as much or as little time as you have** available; become involved on a long term basis or help out at a single event.

Although you won't get paid, you will normally receive any **out of pocket expenses**, be given any **training** or equipment you need, and work in a safe and supportive environment.

So, what shall I do next?

Get in touch with the Volunteer Centre. You can do this by calling in (we offer one to one interviews and all information is confidential) by telephone or via e-mail, or visit our Outreach worker in your area

What happens then?

After an informal interview we will then advise you about the opportunities available, matching your needs and skills and then signposting and linking you with appropriate organisations.

We are then able to contact the groups on your behalf or facilitate the matching service by providing numbers and contacts

The choice is yours

Organisations will then provide specific details regarding the vacancy and arrange an informal interview if required.

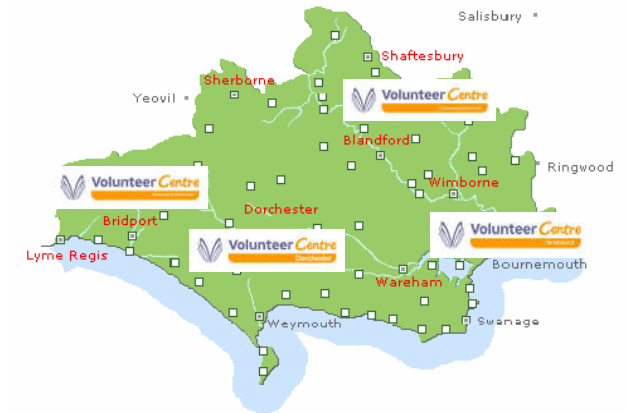
